Terms of Reference

Project: Translation from English to Portuguese for *Equal Eyes*, a bimonthly news digest on global LGBTI communities' stories produced in collaboration with UNAIDS

Background: According to a report published by the Grupo Gay da Bahia (GGB), 420 LGBT people were killed in Brazil in 2018. Out of the 420 murders reported, 39% were gay men, 36% trans people, 12% lesbians and 2% bisexuals. According to data published by project Transgender Europe in 2016, Brazil has the highest absolute numbers in reported transgender killings.

There is an urgent need to provide the LGBT community with quality information and context of what is happening around the world so that they can better understand global trends and how the LGBT debate in Brazil can build strong advocacy initiatives in favor to LGBT rights and inclusion.

Equal Eyes is a powerful tool to raise awareness and advocacy initiatives as it collects significant, timely, and international lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and intersex stories and events. It promotes sexual and gender equality while highlighting issues of health, violence, culture, and legal and human rights. Equal Eyes provides advocates and allies a

common frame of reference for the realities of global LGBTI communities.

The initiative publishes a new digest of curated stories every two-weeks, with easy-to-read narrative highlighting stories from around the world on a variety of topics, considering international topics and UN actions as well as selected localized concerns.

UCO/BRA has been translating, revising and distributing Equal Eyes editions to co-sponsors, partners in the government and civil society since October 2017. Currently, the distribution list for Equal Eyes in Portuguese has 175 subscribers, who receive all editions in their emails.
